

**February 12, 2021 WEEKLY
Update Regarding COVID-19**

Dear Residents and Families,

As a five-star retirement community, our top priority has always been the health and safety of our residents, families, visitors and staff. Lakeview is following guidance from multiple governmental agencies including the United States Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the United States Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE), the Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) and the Johnson County Department of Health and Environment (JCDHE).

Per CMS regulatory guidance, our activity since last Friday is reflected in the following tables:

We have had no additional positive COVID-19 results in Independent Living since December 21st. Since the beginning of the pandemic we have had 21 COVID-19 cases in IL residents with 17 of those residents recovered and 4 who have passed away. Our sympathies go out all who have been affected by COVID-19. **If you are feeling sick or have been recently notified of a COVID-19 exposure, please reach out to Steffany Brosa at 744-2451.**

In the licensed areas, since the first of the year, we have had 21 COVID-19 resident cases between the 1st Floor of the Care Center (19) and Assisted Living (2). Currently 11 residents are being treated on the 3rd Floor COVID unit and 5 more have recovered to the 1st Floor Care Center. Since the beginning of the pandemic in March, we have had **90** licensed area residents test positive for COVID-19 broken out as follows: 48 1st Floor Care Center, 34 2nd Floor Care Center, 3 ET Rehab, and **5** Assisted Living. The last positive resident case in each licensed area is as follows: 1st Floor Care Center - January 30th, 2nd Floor Care Center - December 12th, Eastside Terrace 2nd Floor Rehab - December 27th, and Assisted Living - **February 9th**. We will continue to test Assisted Living, Care Center and ET 2nd floor residents every couple of days and our licensed area staff twice a week. Finding the positive cases early helps minimize the virus spread.

On the employee front, Lakeview has conducted **517** tests in the past week, yielding only **1** positive COVID-19 result in employees. Since the beginning of the pandemic in March, we have had **102** staff test positive for COVID-19. Currently we are down to only **1** staff off work due to positive test results. Any COVID-19 staff will not return to work until cleared by Johnson County Health Department protocols.



Most of our IL residents just received their 2nd round of the COVID-19 vaccine but it will take several weeks before it begins to be effective. Therefore, Lakeview's reopening plan will continue at a slow and cautious pace.

- Outpatient Therapy by appointment only with aquatic therapy available.
- Indoor & outdoor walking provided you wear a mask and maintain 6' feet of social distancing.
- The Art Studio in Northpointe & Woodshop in Heritage are open following social distancing guidelines.
- All high rise common area spaces are open to residents only (no visitors) with 4 unrelated residents allowed per table and residents must wear masks the whole time. Please sign the log book in these common area spaces in the event of a COVID-19 exposure and we need to contact trace.
- IL residents can have visitors in their apartments, on their balconies/patios, and outside provided the resident and visitors wear masks, practice social distancing of at least 6 feet, and limit to less than 5 people. We recommend all visitors be screened at one of the screening areas to help protect everyone's safety. Visitors may not stay overnight unless providing medical assistance.
- Eastside Terrace (744-2306) & Heritage (744-2497) Beauty Shops are open by appointment only.
- Library hours are Mon – Fri, 9:00 - 11:00 & 1:00 - 3:00. No sitting or reading in the library at this time.
- Country Club Bank is open Mon 9:00am-noon, Wed 1:00-4:00pm, Fri 9:00am-noon.
- ET Fitness Center hours are Mon - Fri, 8:00 - 3:30pm.
- ET Aquatic Center is open Mon - Fri, 8:00 - 3:00pm and you must call 951-3812 to get an appointment. The locker rooms must remain closed per Johnson County COVID-19 protocols.
- "On-campus taxi service" (in lieu of regular shuttle service) will be by appointment **only** Mon – Fri, 8:00 – 3:45. Please call 744-2490 to schedule a pick-up and return time.
- What-Not-Shop contactless sales are open to residents and staff only. Items may be purchased by dropping money in the after hour's sale box outside the What-Not-Shop and taking the item with you.
- Pantry "shop at home" ordering continues by calling 951-3831 with your grocery list. Orders placed by noon on Monday will be delivered Wednesday and orders placed by noon on Wednesday will be delivered Friday. Deliveries are made to your doorstep and charges are billed to your resident statement.
- Meals continue to be delivered to your doorstep.

Ongoing Health and Safety Precautions (even after vaccination):

- **W**atch your distance by maintaining 6' between yourself and others.
- **W**ear a mask anytime you are outside your residence (Kansas & Johnson County requirement).
- **W**ash your hands for 20 seconds with soap and water or use hand sanitizer.
- **A**void large gatherings and indoor entertainment venues.
