

**February 26, 2021 WEEKLY
Update Regarding COVID-19**

Dear Residents and Families,

As a five-star retirement community, our top priority has always been the health and safety of our residents, families, visitors and staff. Lakeview is following guidance from multiple governmental agencies including the United States Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the United States Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE), the Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) and the Johnson County Department of Health and Environment (JCDHE).

Per CMS regulatory guidance, our activity since last Friday is reflected in the following tables:

Over the past week, there have been 0 additional cases of COVID-19 on campus. We are looking forward to the final 2 residents on the 3rd Floor COVID unit returning home Monday. The last positive resident case in each of our levels of care are as follows: 1st Floor Care Center - January 30th, 2nd Floor Care Center - December 12th, Eastside Terrace 2nd Floor Rehab - December 27th, Assisted Living - February 9th, and Independent Living – December 21st. **Now that we are 14 days past outbreak status we will reduce testing down to once a week for residents and staff of the licensed areas.**

On the employee front, Lakeview has conducted **525** tests in the past week with **only 1** positive result in employees. Since the beginning of the pandemic in March, we have had **103** staff test positive for COVID-19. Currently we have only 1 staff off work due to positive test results. Any COVID-19 staff will not return to work until cleared by Johnson County Health Department protocols.

Lakeview’s Independent Living reopening plan is shown below with changes in **bold**:

- Outpatient Therapy by appointment only with aquatic therapy available. **Our therapists continue to perform free screenings in the different high rise buildings. Please watch for flyers announcing the exact time and location. These screenings are intended to assess if therapy might be appropriate to improve your mobility, balance, strength, endurance, and cognition after 11 months of limited activities.**
- Indoor & outdoor walking provided you wear a mask and maintain 6’ feet of social distancing.
- The Art Studio in Northpointe & Woodshop in Heritage are open following social distancing guidelines.



- All high rise common area spaces are open to residents only (no visitors) with 4 unrelated residents allowed per table and residents must wear masks the whole time. Please sign the log book in these common area spaces in the event of a COVID-19 exposure and we need to contact trace.
- **Community Life has been planning Zoom activities that will start at the beginning of March. Sign-ups are available now. Please watch for additional information on future activities.**
- IL residents can have visitors in their apartments, on their balconies/patios, and outside provided the resident and visitors wear masks, practice social distancing of at least 6 feet, and limit to less than 5 people. We recommend all visitors be screened at one of the screening areas to help protect everyone's safety. Visitors may not stay overnight unless providing medical assistance.
- **Fitness classes will resume in the Fitness Room/Storm Shelter in the lower level of Eastside Terrace starting the first week of March. A few spaces are still available so hurry and get signed up. The fitness class size is limited so that social distancing can be maintained and wearing a mask is required.**
- Eastside Terrace (744-2306) & Heritage (744-2497) Beauty Shops are open by appointment only.
- **Effective March 1st**, Library hours are Mon – Fri, 9:00 - 11:00 & 1:00 – **4:00pm**. No sitting or reading in the library at this time.
- Country Club Bank is open Mon 9:00am-noon, Wed 1:00-4:00pm, Fri 9:00am-noon.
- **Effective February 22nd**, ET Fitness Center hours are Mon - Fri, 8:00 - **4:30pm**.
- **Effective February 22nd**, ET Aquatic Center is open Mon - Fri, 8:00 - **4:30pm** and you must call 951-3812 to get an appointment. **The aquatic locker rooms are open for changing only. These locker rooms can only be used by the pool swimmers ONLY and NOT the fitness room users per Johnson County regulations.**
- **The on campus Bus Shuttle Service has resumed operation 8:30 – 4PM M-F. The buses run between all the high-rises every ½ hour. If you live in a cottage and need to be picked up please call 744-2490 to schedule your pick-up time.**
- What-Not-Shop contactless sales are open to residents and staff only. Items may be purchased by dropping money in the after hour's sale box outside the What-Not-Shop and taking the item with you.
- Pantry "shop at home" ordering continues by calling 951-3831 with your grocery list. Orders placed by noon on Monday will be delivered Wednesday and orders placed by noon on Wednesday will be delivered Friday. Deliveries are made to your doorstep and charges are billed to your resident statement.
- Meals continue to be delivered to your doorstep. **We are actively working on Dining Room reopening plans. We are recruiting more servers to be able to provide excellent meal service so if you know of any one interested please refer them to Lakeview.**
- **Art Gallery Sale is going on in ET. Please note a large collection of art is currently for sale due to the recent passing of a Lakeview artist.**

Ongoing Health and Safety Precautions (even after vaccination):

- **Watch your distance** by maintaining 6' between yourself and others.
- **Wear a mask** anytime you are outside your residence (Kansas & Johnson County requirement).
- **Wash your hands** for 20 seconds with soap and water or use hand sanitizer.
- Avoid large gatherings and indoor entertainment venues.
- Screening for all residents, employees, and visitors at the entries of Heritage, Northpointe, & Southridge
- Contact tracing and logging will need to continue in the event of a COVID-19 outbreak

We are looking forward to see more residents out and about on campus. Remember to always wear your mask and maintain 6 feet of distance to help protect yourself and others.
