Dear Residents and Families,

As a five-star retirement community, our top priority has always been the health and safety of our residents, families, visitors and staff. Lakeview is following guidance from multiple governmental agencies including the United States Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the United States Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE), the Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services (KDADS) and the Johnson County Department of Health and Environment (JCDHE).

Lakeview will be hosting COVID-19 vaccination clinics weekly for the foreseeable future. Please inform everyone you know about the availability of the COVID-19 vaccine here on our campus.

Lakeview's Independent Living reopening plan is shown below with changes in **bold**:

- Outpatient Therapy by appointment only with aquatic therapy available. Outpatient Therapy is willing to provide a free screening for those who have seen a change in their mobility, balance, strength, endurance and cognition after 12 months of limited activities. Call 913-744-2482 for a screening appointment.
- Indoor and outdoor walking without a mask provided 6' feet of social distancing can be maintained.
- The Art Studio in Northpointe & Woodshop in Heritage are open following social distancing guidelines.
- All high-rise common area spaces are open to residents, still no outside guests in common area rooms.
- Contact the Front Desk at 913- 888-1900 to sign up for Zoom activities currently promoted on Channel 2.
- **Community Life will be offering small group activities. Please contact the Heritage Reception desk for more information and to sign up.**



- IL residents can have visitors in their apartments, on their balconies/patios, and outside. We recommend all visitors be screened at one of the screening areas to help protect everyone's safety. Visitors may not stay overnight unless providing medical assistance. Please be aware that the state of Kansas has now listed New York, New Jersey, Delaware, Michigan, Rhode Island, Pennsylvania, & **Minnesota** as states you must quarantine upon return if you are unvaccinated.
- Fitness classes have resumed in the Fitness Room/Storm Shelter in the lower level of Eastside Terrace. Please call 744-2437 to sign up for these classes. The fitness class size is limited so that social distancing can be maintained and wearing a mask is required.
- Outdoor self-directed wellness activities resumed April 1st. Please see App or Channel 2 for details.
- **Bible Study groups are resuming. Please contact Chaplin Quentin Jones at (913) 744-2415 for more information.**
- Eastside Terrace (744-2306) & Heritage (744-2497) Beauty Shops are open by appointment only.
- The Library has returned to their normal hours of Mon – Fri, 9:00 - 11:00 & 1:00 – 4:00pm. **Residents are able to sit and read items at the table provided social distance is maintained.**
- Country Club Bank is open Mon 9:00am-noon, Wed 1:00-4:00pm, Fri 9:00am-noon.
- **ET Computer Lab is open at full capacity provided you wear a mask.**
- The ET Fitness Center hours are Mon - Fri, 8:00am - 4:30pm.
- The ET Aquatic Center is open Mon - Fri, 8:00am - 4:30pm and you must call 951-3812 to get an appointment. The aquatic locker rooms are open for changing only. These locker rooms can only be used by the pool swimmers ONLY and NOT the fitness room users per Johnson County regulations.
- The on campus Bus Shuttle Service operates Mon – Fri, **8am – 4pm**. The buses run between all the high-rises every ½ hour. **Buses will resume full capacity so you will need to wear your mask while on the bus.** If you live in a cottage and need to be picked up please call 744-2490.
- **Off Campus Bus Shuttle Service to local grocery stores (HyVee, Hen House, & Aldi's) will resume Wednesday, May 5th. Please call the Transportation Hotline at (913) 744-2490 to sign up.**
- Delivery Services including pharmacies can now bring their packages to your doorstep.
- What-Not-Shop contactless sales are open to residents and staff only. Items may be purchased by dropping money in the after-hours sale box outside the What-Not-Shop and taking the item with you.
- Pantry “shop at home” ordering continues by calling 951-3831 with your grocery list. Orders placed by noon on Monday will be delivered Wednesday and orders placed by noon on Wednesday will be delivered Friday. Deliveries are made to your doorstep and charges are billed to your resident statement.
- The Heritage, Northpointe, and Southridge dining rooms are open with reservation seating only. Starting Monday, April 19th, we have added a 4:30 reservation time for our dining rooms. Also, we have added a few larger tables for those who would like to dine with more friends. Please call the dining room of your choice to modify your reservation. **The Northpointe patio will begin offering outdoor seating next week.**
- For those not eating in the Dining Rooms, meals will continue to be delivered to your doorstep. If you would like to change from at home to dining room meals, please call the dining room of your choice.
- ET 1st Floor main entry door will be open from 8:30-4:30 Monday - Friday for residents and clients going to the 1st floor of ET (outpatient, fitness gym, clinic, pool), art gallery and fitness classes.
- **Normal indoor & outdoor visits are available for almost anyone in the licensed areas. If you have any questions on visitation please reach out to your Social Worker.**
