

Lakeview's Independent Living reopening plan is as follows. **For the most up to date hours and openings, please check the Community App or tune into Channel 2:**

- Lakeview has installed computerized screening kiosks at our main entries. At this time, we are asking our residents to sign-in as "Guest" so that you will receive a sticker. This sticker is needed if you are going to access any of the public spaces, events, or licensed areas on campus.
- Beauty Shops by appointment with **masks required in the Beauty Shops per Johnson County guidelines.**
- Outpatient Therapy by appointment only with aquatic therapy available – **masks are required in Outpatient Therapy per clinic guidelines.** Call 913-744-2482 for a screening appointment.
- **Masks are required in the Physicians Clinic per guidelines.**
- Masks are **encouraged** when indoor or outdoor walking and unable to social distance.
- **Please check the Kansas website for current quarantine guidelines for unvaccinated individuals.**

- The Village Market (formerly known as The Pantry) has reopened M-F 9:30-11AM and 2:30-4PM.
- What-Not-Shop contactless sales are open to residents and staff only. Hours are 10am – 8pm M-F.
- The Heritage, Northpointe (outdoor seating now available), and Southridge dining rooms are open with reservation seating only. Off-campus guests may join residents for dinner in these 3 dining rooms.
- The Heritage Dining Room is now open for lunch with reservations.
- Social Hour is back Tues at Heritage, Wed at Northpointe and Thurs at Southridge, between 4 - 5:30pm.
- The Bistro is open with specialty coffees and locally produced pastries, sandwiches and salads.
- If you wish to visit someone in the licensed areas, please remember you must go through screening and get a printed sticker that you wear in an easily visible place. Lakeview is following CMS visitation guidelines. CMS requires all visitors to use a well fitted mask (K95 or N95) and encourages eye protection to be worn while in the licensed areas. **Currently, 4th Floor ET Assisted Living & 1st Floor Care Center have Compassionate Care or outdoor visits only. 2nd Floor Care Center & 2nd & 3rd Floor ET Rehab have resumed normal indoor visitation.**
- The Chapel has resumed live/in person services in the Heritage Activity Center with seating capacity limited to 62. Please contact the Reception desk to make a reservation.

Just as the COVID pandemic continues so does our struggle with staffing. Currently you are seeing the highest effect from these staffing struggles in our dining rooms. Unfortunately, we have less than 50% of our server positions filled which is causing delays during our busiest dining times. **The newly implemented 25% pay increase for our servers is paying off with 14 applications in the last few days. You will be seeing both new and familiar faces in the dining rooms while we work to fill the open server positions. We continue to ask for your help and patience. If you are willing to change your dining time or switch to meal pick-up it would be greatly appreciated. Just call your dining room and ask to make the change.**

We all need to be careful while out in the general public or tight indoor spaces. At this time both the CDC and Lakeview are strongly recommending our residents to wear masks both on and off campus when indoors or in large gatherings. Please stay safe and stay health.
