COVID-19 Positive Cases**

RE: **Positive Cases of COVID-19**

Dear Independent Living Residents and Families,

We are writing today to provide an update about COVID-19 on the Lakeview campus.

Today alone, we have had 5 Independent Living residents test positive (and we are still testing) for COVID-19, the illness resulting from the novel coronavirus. Any residents or staff who have had contact with anyone that tested positive have been notified.

We continue to see milder symptoms in our vaccinated residents than we saw last winter before vaccinations. We continue to urge residents to follow good infection control protocols by washing their hands frequently and practicing social distancing. Those that are immunocompromised or have significant health issues may want to consider wearing a mask when they are around groups of people.

PLEASE, IF YOU ARE FEELING SICK, STAY HOME. We have seen a spread among residents even though they thought it was just allergies or mild cold symptoms. We ask that you reach out to your physician via telephone to discuss the changes in your health conditions and **contact Steffany Brosa at 913-744-2451 to make essential arrangements such as COVID-19 testing and meals.**

Please remember we offer COVID-19 testing and vaccinations to anyone on the Lakeview campus including visitors. As a CDC vaccination clinic site, we have Pfizer and Moderna vaccines available and continue to offer almost daily vaccine clinics to make it as convenient as possible to receive the vaccine. **Please help us get more people vaccinated by passing along our COVID-19 Vaccination Hotline of 913-951-3879.**
